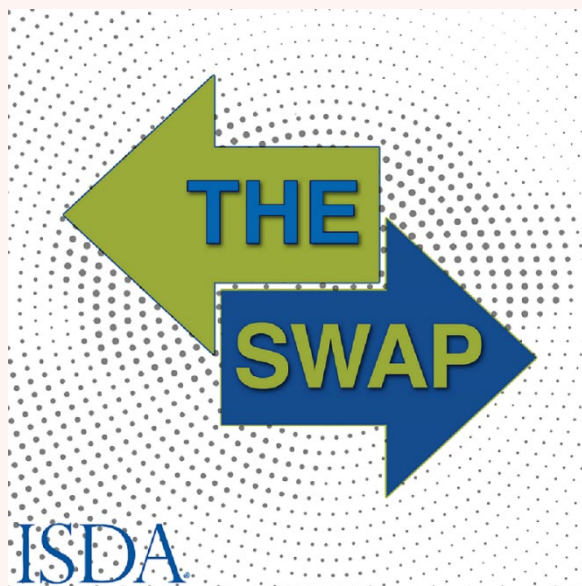
[ISDA Board Appoints New Chair as Eric Litvack Steps Down After 10 Years](#)
